

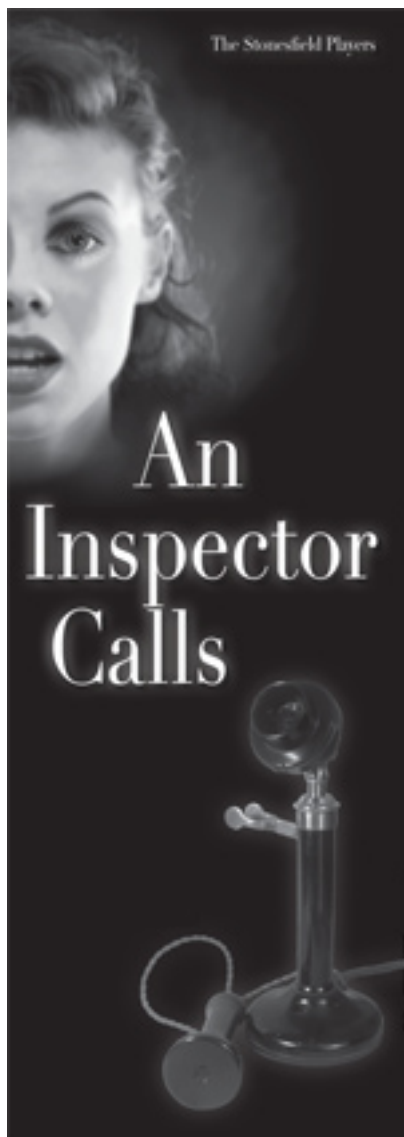

Spring Production

I am planning to direct *Our Town*, by Thornton Wilder. It is an early twentieth century play about a small town in America, very like Stonesfield. It has a large cast, with three children (two boys and a girl) aged about 11; two teenagers (boy and girl) aged about 16, who also play a slightly older version of themselves; and plenty of adults of both sexes.

The young children have very few lines but are on stage in central scenes. The teenagers are leading roles. The adult parts vary in size. There will be two rehearsals per week, 8 – 10 pm. It will be performed on stage on 1 and 2 April 2011.

I will be holding auditions in January, on a date yet to be fixed. If you would like to come to the auditions, please phone me now. If I am out,

leave a message with your name, age (if you are over 20, don't bother to give your age!) and telephone number. I will be in touch with you in the New Year, and there will be another Newsletter or email before then with further details.

Please also have a think about getting involved, whether it's to help with costume, make-up, lights, design, publicity, props or staging. I also need a really good producer. All offers gratefully received.
